## **ORDER**

Smt. A. Shanti Yadav, Hyderabad has filed a Complaint dated 13-11-2019 which was received by this Commission on 13-11-2019 for not getting the information sought by her from the PIO / O/o The Tahsildar, Marpally Mandal, Vikarabad District.

The brief facts of the case as per the Complaint and other records received along with it are that the Complainant herein filed an application dated 19-09-2019 before the PIO under Sec.6(1) of the RTI Act, 2005, requesting to furnish the information on the following points mentioned in her application annexed.

I undersigned Smt. Annaboina Shanti Yadav w/o A.Dayakar Yadav submit I am the absolute registered owner and possessor of the Agricultural Lands in Sy.No.150, admeasuring Ac.8.34 Gts, situated at Ghanapur village, Marpalli Mandal, Dist. Vikarabad-TS having purchased from Md.Moiz @ Md.Moizuddin s/o Md.Salar under Regd. Sale Deed no.4652/2011, dated: 26-11-2011 and since then I am in possession of the said lands. That in July, 2018 I applied for the Patta pass book and makes claim of Cheques (under Rythu Bandu Scheme) and said Revenue Authorities allotted Patta Pass Book No. T07100020543 & Khata No. 991. That the concerned V.R.O. Sri Mohan instead of handing over the Patta Book and Cheques, he handed over the said Patta book and Cheques to my father Nagan Papaiah Yadav, brother Sri N. Sandeep Yadav and Sri N.Mallesha Yadav for which I made a complaint to the Revenue (Assn-II) Department and the concerned Asst. Sec.to Govt (FAC) directed the Spl.Chief Secretary & Chief Commissioner of Land Admin, Hyderabad / The Collector, Vikarabad ; Hyderabad to examine the issue and take immediate necessary action. That again 13-10-2018 I made another application before Tahsildar, Marpalli, R.D.O Vikarabad and Collector Vikarabad demanding that the Patta Pass Book and Cheque under Rythu Bandu shall be returned me.

I request the concerned Tahsildar, Marpalli Mandal, Vikarabad to provide the information unde R.T.I. Act,2005 about the status of my applications dated: 13-10-2018 and 17-11-2018 for which I enclosed the Postal Order of Rs.20/- dated: 19-09-2019 and I ready to pay the required requisite fee for obtaining the above information.

The Public Information Officer has not furnished the information to the complainant.

As the Complainant did not receive the required information from the PIO even after 30 days of filing her application, she preferred this Complaint before the Commission u/s 18(1) of the RTI Act, 2005 requesting to arrange to furnish the information sought by her.

The Complaint was taken on file and the case was posted for hearing over phone on 05-08-2020.

On overview spread of COVID-19, the case was heard over phone on 05-08-2020. Both the parties were contacted on telephone. The Complainant and the representative of the Public Information Officer were heard.

The Complainant submitted that he did not receive the sought information from the Public Information Officer.

P.T.O

The representative of the Public Information Officer submitted that the post of the Public Information Officer was vacant and the Tahsildar concerned was quarantined due to COVID-19. The Commission after going through the records noticed that the appellant sought information with regard to her Agricultural Land Patta Pass Book concerning survey no. 150 situated at Ghanapur Village, Marpalli Mandal, Vikarabad District and the cheque issued under Rythu Bandhu Scheme handed over to his father Sri Nagan Papaiah Yadav and brother Sri N. Sandeep Yadav without her knowledge.

The case called on 05-08-2020 was adjourned to 26-11-2020 with a direction to the Public Authority / The Tahsildar concerned to see that a responsible officer may be designated as Public Information Officer immediately and information sought may be furnished to the complainant within two weeks time from the date of receipt of this order under intimation to the Commission.

On 26-11-2020 the case is called. The Complainant is absent. The Public Information Officer / O/o The Tahsildar, Marpally Mandal, Vikarabad District is absent.

Both the parties are absent.

The Commission observed that after passing interim order by the Telangana State Information Commission, the Public Information Officer failed to appear before the Commission.

The Commission directs the Public Information Officer to furnish complete information to the complainant within one week from the date of receipt of this order and to report compliance to the Commission.

With the above direction, the complaint is closed.

**Issue Show Cause Notice to the PIOs concerned failing to furnish information and failing to respond/appear before the Commission on the date of hearing. This will be dealt separately.**
