ORDER

Sri Satheesh Maraju, Hyderabad has filed 2nd appeal dated 03-11-2020 which was received by this Commission on 04-11-2020 for not getting the information sought by him from the PIO / O/o the Tahsildar, Mandal Revenue Officer, Telkapally Mandal, Nagarkurnool District and 1st Appellate Authority / O/o the Chief Commissioner of Land Administration, Nampally Station Road, Hyderabad.

The brief facts of the case as per the appeal and other records received along with it are that the appellant herein filed an application dated **11-08-2020** before the PIO under Sec.6(1) of the RTI Act, 2005, requesting to furnish the information on the following points mentioned in his application:

SUB: 1) Status of my Appeal dated on 13th-July-2020 through an electronic e-mail to the Honorable Additional Collector, 2) Status and detailed report on pending following Appeals at Honorable collector that is i) Ref.No. CCLAS. ROR1/640/2019 dated.30/05/2020, ii) Ref.No. CCLAS. Settlement-II/53/2020 dated.28/01 /2020, iii) CCLAS, Ref.No.Vegilance-5/23/2020 dated.25/01/2020, iv) CCLAS Ref.No. ROR1/ 923 /2019 dt.20/07/2019, v) CCLAS Ref.No. Settlement-II/170/2020 dated. 04/06/2020.

Under the Right to Information Act, 2005, Section 6, I need some information. The details of the information are as follows:

2. Period to which the information relates
From the Date: 30/05/2019 to 07/08/2020.

3. Details of Information

BACKGROUND:

I am Satheesh Maraju, S/o Late-Maraju Ramaswamy R/o Gouraram-(Village), Telkapally (Mandl), Nagarkurnool District.

We have agricultural land an extent of Ac.18.37gts in Sy.No.13 and an extent of Ac.0.18gts in Sy.No.51 an extent of Ac.0.25gts in Sy.No.89 situated Gowraram Village. The land is belongs to my grandmother Smt. Late Vadia Narayanamma D/o Vadia Ambhaiah, and my grandmother was INAMDHAR as per Original KASARA PAHANI and she were as PATTADAR as per 1B-ROR record which were made by the Tahasildar Telkapally during the year in 1989 - 1993 under ROR act-1971.

After death of my grandmother our respondent's family was tampered and manipulated the original KASARAPAHANI and ROR record without any proceedings with the help of revenue officials and taken advantages absent our family present in the village. Due to these illegal entries without proceeding in revenue records Telkapally Tahasildar Mr.Srinivasulu Mundarinti was granted an illegal 1B-ROR and PAHANI certified copies to our respondent's family to the extent of Ac.11.10gts in Sy.No.13 and to the extent of Ac. 1.03gts land in Sy.No.51 & 89. Even after pre intimation regarding the dispute, hence I requested for correction of the revenue records.

In the light of the above mentioned background, please provide the following information under section 2(j) of the RTI act.

- Status of Appeal regarding Correction of the KASARA PAHANI, 1B-ROR record and PAHANIES dt.13/07/2020 through an email.
- Status and detailed report on pending Appeal at Honorable Collector that is Ref.No. CCLAS. ROR1/640/2019 dt.30/05/2020.
- Status and detailed report on pending Appeal at Honorable Collector that is Ref.No. CCLAS. Settlement-II/53/2020 dt.28/01 /2020.
- Status and detailed report on pending Appeal at Honorable Collector that is CCLAS, Ref.No.Vegilance-5/23/2020 dt.25/01/2020.
- Status and detailed report on pending Appeal at Honorable Collector that is CCLAS Ref.No. ROR1/ 923 /2019 dt.20/07/2019.
- Status and detailed report on pending Appeal at Honorable Collector that is CCLAS Ref.No. Settlement-II/170/2020 dt.04/06/2020.

5. Below Items are for your kind information and consideration

- As per section 6(3) of the RTI Act 2005, In case, the requested information is held by another public authority, I request the PIO to transfer the application or part of it within FIVE days and immediately inform me about such transfer.
- As per section 7(3) of the RTI Act 2005, In case, there are further fee required to provide the requested information, I request the PIO to inform me of the additional fee amount along with the calculations made to arrive at the amount.
- As per section 7(8)(iii) and 7(3)(ii) of the RTI Act 2005, I request the PIO to inform me of the particulars of First Appellate Authority.

6. Declaration

I declare that I am a citizen of India.

P.T.O

The Public Information Officer has not furnished the information to the appellant.

Since the appellant did not receive the information from the Public Information Officer, he filed 1st appeal dated **01-10-2020** before the 1st Appellate Authority u/s 19(1) of the RTI Act, 2005 requesting him to furnish the information sought by him.

The 1st Appellate Authority has not furnished the information to the Appellant.

As the appellant did not get the information from the Public Information Officer / 1st Appellate Authority even after 30 days of filing his 1st appeal, he preferred this 2nd appeal before this Commission u/s 19(3) of the RTI Act, 2005 requesting to take action against the PIO and 1st Appellate Authority for not furnishing information sought by him and also to arrange to furnish the information sought by him.

The Appeal was taken on file and the case is posted for hearing on 17-03-2021.

“The case is called on 17-03-2021. The Appellant is present. The Public Information Officer / Sri R. Laxman, Naib Tahsildar is present. The First Appellate Authority is absent. Smt G. Lakshmi, Superintendent is present on behalf of the First Appellate Authority.

The Appellant submitted that he has not received any information from the Public Information Officer. He also submitted that in khasara pahani tampering was done by the respondents. He further submitted that the then Mandal Revenue Officer has sent the report to Joint Collector and Collector office, but they refused to furnish a copy to him.

The Public Information Officer submitted that certified copy of pahanies from the 1991-92, 1992-93 and Khasra pahani of 1954-55 are furnished to the appellant. He also submitted that proceeding copies will be furnished from RDO Office.

On perusal of case record, it was seen that there is no proper response from the Public Information Officer concerned. The Commission directed the Public Information Officer / O/o. The Revenue Divisional Officer, Nagarkurnool to furnish the proceeding copy for change of ownership and Tahsildar, Telkapally Mandal to furnish the legal heir certificate and other available information to the appellant and to appear before the Commission on the next date of hearing.”

The case was adjourned to 02-09-2021.

The case is called on 02-09-2021. The Appellant is present. The Public Information Officer-1 is absent. Syed Muzaffar Hussain, Administrative Officer O/o. The Revenue Divisional Officer, Nagarkurnool Division is present on behalf of the Public Information Officer. The Public Information Officer-2/ Sri R.Laxman, Naib Thasildar is present. The First Appellate Authority is absent. Sri Pandu, Superintendent is present on behalf of the Appellate Authority.

The Appellant submitted that he has received the part information from the Public Information Officer. He also submitted that he has not received the ORC copies from the Public Information Officer.

The Public Information Officer submitted that as per directions of the Commission the family member certificate has furnished to the appellant on vide letter No. A/460/2021 dated 14-06-2021.

Heard both the parties and perused the material papers available on record. The Commission directed the Public Information Officer-1 to furnish the ORC copies to the appellant, within two weeks from the date of receipt of this order and to report compliance to the Commission.

With the above direction, the appeal is closed.
