ORDER

Sri L. Loganathan has filed 2nd appeal dated 03-10-2022 which was received by this Commission on 03-10-2022 for not getting the information sought by him from the PIO / O/o. the Special Deputy Collector Land Acquisition (L.A), Unit-IV, ORRP, HMDA, Nanakramguda, Ranga Reddy Dist and 1st Appellate Authority / O/o. the Special Deputy Collector Land Acquisition (L.A), Unit-IV, ORRP, HMDA, Nanakramguda, Ranga Reddy Dist.

The brief facts of the case as per the appeal and other records received along with it are that the appellant herein filed an application dated **26-05-2022** before the PIO under Sec.6(1) of the RTI Act, 2005, requesting to furnish the information on the following points mentioned in his application:

I am the S.P.A Holder of Sri L Loganathan who is the owner and possessor of the land in Plot No 24 admeasuring 200 square yards in Sy No 109/B, situated at Chirayal Village, Keesara Mandal Ranga Reddy District

I submit that there was Land Acquisition Proceedings where in Plot No 24 is also effected, in this connection it is submitted that the following information be furnished Under the R.T.I Act

1. Copy of Award of Land Acquisition be furnished.
2. How much extent of land is acquired in Plot No 24 is acquired
3. What is the compensation awarded in respect of Plot No 24
4. To whom the said compensation was paid
5. Copy of G.O. Ms NO 14 dated 18-12-2006 be furnished
6. Copies of Claim Petitions, objections, and documents be furnished in respect of Plot No 24

The Public Information Officer has not furnished the information to the appellant.

Since the appellant did not receive the information from the Public Information Officer, he filed 1st appeal dated **18-07-2022** before the 1st Appellate Authority U/s. 19(1) of the RTI Act, 2005 requesting him to furnish the information sought by him.

The 1st Appellate Authority failed to hear the case and pass appropriate orders on the 1st appeal filed before him.

As the appellant did not get the information from the Public Information Officer / 1st Appellate Authority even after 30 days of filing his 1st appeal, he preferred this 2nd appeal before this Commission U/s. 19(3) of the RTI Act, 2005 requesting to take action against the PIO and 1st Appellate Authority for not furnishing information sought by him and also to arrange to furnish the information sought by him.

Basing on the material papers available on record, the appeal was taken on file and notices were sent to the parties concerned directing them to appear before this Commission for hearing on 19-01-2023.

The case is called on 19-01-2023. The Appellant is present. Sri M.Bikshapathi, Tahsildar is present on behalf of the Public Information Officer. The First Appellate Authority is absent.

The Appellant submitted that he did not receive any information from the Public Information Officer.

The representative of the Public Information Officer submitted that he has sent the available information to the appellant through post, vide Memo letter No. LA/Unit-IV/38-1/2005 dated 18-01-2023 today.

Since the appellant stated that he did not receive any information, the Commission directed the Public Information Officer to furnish a copy of the information to the appellant and the same is furnished in the presence of the Commission.

The Appellant has verified the information furnished to him by the Public Information Officer and submitted that information on point No.6 is not available.

The Commission directed the Public Information Officer to make a thorough search and furnish the information on point No.6 to the appellant, within two weeks from the date of receipt of this order and submit compliance report to the Commission.

With the above direction, the appeal is closed.
