ORDER

Sri A. Venkata Ramulu has filed 2nd appeal dated 18-10-2022 which was received by this Commission on 19-10-2022 for not getting the information sought by him from the Public Information Officer / O/o. the Assistant Director, Survey and Land Records, Siddipet District-502103 and 1st Appellate Authority / O/o. the District Collector, Siddipet District-502103.

The brief facts of the case as per the appeal and other records received along with it are that the appellant herein filed an application dated **20-04-2022** before the Public Information Officer under Sec.6(1) of the RTI Act, 2005, requesting to furnish the information on the following points:

I respectfully submit that I am an Agriculturist of Jagadevpur Village having farmlands inter alia in Sy. No. 760/ .Vide reference cited above, the Government acquired agricultural lands for re-alignment of Road from Pragnapur to Bhongir. Accordingly, land belonging to 1) Adarajupally Metrama Rao 2) Adarajupally Venkata Ramulu (me) and 3) Mangali Vishnu in Sy No. 760/ of Jagadevpur village,

Now dispute arose amongst us viz. Adarajupally Metrama Rao, Adarajupally Venkata Ramulu (me) and Mangali Vishnu as to their land holdings in the said Sy No 760/ ,

In view of the above, I humbly pray your good selves to inform the extent of land acquired by the Government for the purpose from me i.e. Adarajupally Venkata Ramulu, Adarajupally Metrama Rao and Mangali Vishnu in Sy No. 760/ of Jagadevpur Village. Alternately I request to provide a copy of acquittance of compensation amount paid to farmers of Survey No. 760/ of Jagadevpur Village.

The Public Information Officer has not furnished the information to the appellant.

Since the appellant did not receive the information from the Public Information Officer, he filed 1st appeal dated **02-08-2022** before the 1st Appellate Authority U/s. 19(1) of the RTI Act, 2005 requesting him to furnish the information sought by him.

The 1st Appellate Authority / O/o. the District Collector, Siddipet District-502103, vide Lr.No. H7/3142/2022, dated 22-08-2022 has transferred the 1st appeal U/s. 6(3) of the RTI Act to the 1st Appellate Authority / O/o. the Assistant Director, Survey and Land Records, Siddipet District to furnish the information to the applicant.

As the appellant did not get the information from the Public Information Officer / 1st Appellate Authority even after 30 days of filing his 1st appeal, he preferred this 2nd appeal before this Commission U/s. 19(3) of the RTI Act, 2005 requesting to take action against the Public Information Officer and 1st Appellate Authority for not furnishing information sought by him and also to arrange to furnish the information sought by him.

Basing on the material papers available on record, the appeal was taken on file and notices were sent to the parties concerned directing them to appear before this Commission for hearing on 20-02-2023.

The case is called on 20-02-2023. The Appellant is present. The Public Information Officer/ Sri B.Srinivas, Deputy Inspector of Survey is present. The First Appellate Authority is absent.

The Appellant submitted that he did not receive the sought information from the Public Information Officer.

The Public Information Officer submitted that the appellant has given proceeding number in his 6(1) application and seeking information with regard to Jagadevpur Village, but when he has searched basing on the said proceeding number, he found that the said proceeding relates to Alirajpet Village and sought time to verify and furnish the information relating to Jagadevpur Village as sought by the appellant.

In view of the above submission of the Public Information Officer, the Commission directed the Public Information Officer to verify and furnish the sought information to the appellant, within two weeks from the date of receipt of this order and submit compliance report to the Commission.

With the above direction, the appeal is closed.
