ORDER

Sri H. Mahalinga Prasad, R/o. Hyderabad District has filed a Complaint dated 05-06-2019 which was received by this Commission on 07-06-2019 for not getting the information sought by him from the PIO / O/o. the Deputy Commissioner, GHMC, Circle No.15, Musheerabad, Hyderabad.

The brief facts of the case as per the Complaint and other records received along with it are that the Complainant herein filed an application dated 30-03-2018 under Sec.6(1) of the RTI Act, 2005, before the PIO seeking following information:

This is in response to your reply dated 23-06-2016 (find enclosed the copy), I would like to bring to your notice that your office has not clarified us with proper information about our query of seeking information about whether Dangoria Maternity Hospital & Nursing Home located at 1-7-1074, RTC x Roads owned by Dr. Devyani Dangoria & family a 100 bedded hospital in a commercial complex which is adjacent to our residential apartment has obtained all legal permissions & licenses to run such a big hospital in the residential area? Does the hospital has adequate infrastructure & facilities as required by law to run a big nursing home?

If yes please provide us the copies of the permission taken from your office at the earliest. If not please let us know what legal action your office will initiate against Dangoria Hospital for running such big hospital illegally under right to information act within a week time under the right to information act.

The PIO has not furnished the sought information to the complainant.

As the complainant did not receive the sought information from the PIO even after 30 days of filing his application, he preferred this Complaint before the Commission requesting to arrange to furnish the information sought by him.

The Complaint was taken on file and notices were issued to both the parties for hearing on 06-07-2021.

On 06-07-2021 the case is called. The Complainant is present. The PIO / Assistant Medical Health Officer, GHMC, Circle-15, Hyderabad is present.

The Complainant submitted that he did not receive the sought information.

The Public Information Officer submitted that the factual information of their office was furnished on 06-07-2021 by hand. She further submitted that with regard to infrastructure & facilities the matter is related to District Medical and Health Officer, Hyderabad. The PIO is directed to transfer the 6 (1) application to the PIO / O/o. the District Medical and Health Officer, Hyderabad and after receipt of 6 (1) application, the PIO / O/o. the District Medical and Health Officer, Hyderabad is directed to furnish factual information to the complainant within (15) days and submit compliance to the Commission.

With the above direction, the case was adjourned to 26-04-2022 for compliance of the PIO. The Registry is directed to issue fresh notice to PIO / O/o. the District Medical and Health Officer, Hyderabad to appear in person along with connected records on the next date of hearing.

On 26-04-2022 the case is called. The Complainant is absent. The Public Information Officer / Assistant Medical & Health Officer, O/o the Deputy Commissioner, Circle-15, Musheerabad, GHMC, Hyderabad is present.

The case was earlier heard and adjourned **on 06-07-2021** with a direction to Public Information Officer to transfer 6(1) application to the Public Information Officer / DMHO, Hyderabad who in turn was directed to furnish information to the Complainant within (15) days from the date of receipt of this order and report compliance to the Commission.

The Public Information Officer / AMOH submitted that the 6(1) application was transferred to the Public Information Officer / DMHO, Hyderabad.

The appellant did not choose to attend the hearing nor filed affidavit offering his version.

Hence, the Commission directs the Public Information Officer / DMHO, Hyderabad to furnish information of their office to the Complainant **within (15) days** from the date of receipt of this order and submit compliance to the Commission.

With the above direction, **the Complaint is closed.**
