Order

Sri M.S. Vijaya Prasad filed complaint dated **09-09-2021** which was received by this Commission on **13-09-2021** stating that the Public Information Officer/ O/o the Deputy Commissioner, GHMC, Chandanagar, Ranga Reddy District did not implement the Commission Order in Appeal No. 9188/SIC-MNR/2019 dated 09-03-2021.

The complainant stated that he was not satisfied with the reply of the Public Information Officer, he preferred this Complaint before the Commission requesting to arrange to furnish the information sought by him u/s 18(1) of the RTI Act, 2005.

In view of the above, notice is issued to both the parties to attend for hearing on **09-03-2022 at 10.30 AM.**

The Case is heard on 09-03-2022. The complainant is present and stated that the PIO has not furnished the relevant information. The PIO/ Sri P.Krishnamurthy, Town Planning Supervisor, GHMC, Circle – 21, Chandanagar, Seriglingampally Zone is present and through affidavit stated that vide Ir.No.RTI/08/TPS/Cir-21/2019-2021, dated.19-03-2021 the appellant was informed that the information sought by him is not available and requested to provide him File No. or Permit No. to furnish the information.

Heard both the parties and perused the material papers available on record. The Commission observed that the PIO has not furnished the information to the complainant. The Commission took a serious view against Public Information Officer for not furnishing the information to the complainant within the stipulated period of 30 days as per section 7(1) of the RTI Act 2005. The Commission warns the PIO not to repeat such lapses in future and strictly adhere to the provisions of the RTI Act 2005.

Hence the Commission directs the PIO to furnish the information to the complainant within one week through RPAD and to report compliance to the Commission. If the PIO fails to comply with the instructions issued, action will be initiated against the PIO as per Section 20 of the RTI Act, 2005.

With the above direction, the complaint is closed.
