Order

Sri P. Mukunda Reddy has filed second appeal dated **24-04-2020** which was received by this Commission on **25-04-2020** for not getting the information sought by him from the Public Information Officer/ The Deputy Tahsildar, Alwal Mandal, Medchal – Malkajgiri District and the First Appellate Authority/ The Revenue Divisional Officer, Malkajgiri, Medchal – Malkajgiri District.

The brief facts of the case as per the appeal and other records received along with it are that the appellant herein filed an application dated **21-11-2019** before the Public Information Officer requesting to furnish the information under Sec. 6(1) of the RTI Act, 2005 on the following points mentioned:

Stating that the appellant did not get any response from the Public Information Officer, he filed 1st appeal dated **18-01-2020** before the First Appellate Authority requesting him to furnish the information sought by him u/s 19(1) of the RTI Act, 2005.

The Public Information Officer through Endorsement No. B/238/2020 dated 17-02-2020 furnished available information to the appellant and for remaining information the applicant may approach to the Assistant Director., Survey & Land Records.

The First Appellate Authority through Notice dated 25-02-2020 directed the Public Information Officer and the appellant to appear for hearing on 25-02-2020 at 11.00 AM along with related records/ documents.

The First Appellate Authority through Memo dated 03-2020 informed that the Public Information Officer furnished the available information to the appellant. Hence, the appeal is closed.

Stating that the appellant was not satisfied with the reply of the First Appellate Authority, he preferred this 2nd appeal before this Commission requesting to arrange to furnish the information sought by him u/s 19(3) of the RTI Act, 2005.

In view of the above, notice is issued to both the parties to attend for hearing on **18-01-2022 at 10.30 AM.**

The Case was heard on 18-01-2022. The appellant is absent. The PIO/Smt.S.Renuka Devi, Naib Tahsildar, Alwal Mandal, Medchal Malkajgiri District is present and stated that vide letter No.B/238/2020, dated.17-02-2020 the available information was furnished to the appellant through registered post. The PIO further submitted a copy of the information before the Commission along with the copy of the postal receipt.

Heard the PIO and perused the material papers available on record. The Commission observed that the PIO has furnished the available information to the appellant.

Since the information is furnished, the appeal is closed.
