Order

Sri B. Appa Rao has filed second appeal dated **12-01-2021** which was received by this Commission on **15-01-2021** for not getting the information sought by him from the Public Information Officer/ O/o the GM, SCCL., Singareni Bhavan, Hyderabad and the First Appellate Authority/ O/o the SCCL., Kothagudem, Bhadradi – Kothagudem District.

The brief facts of the case as per the appeal and other records received along with it are that the appellant herein filed an application dated **05-10-2020** before the Public Information Officer requesting to furnish the information under Sec. 6(1) of the RTI Act, 2005 on the following points mentioned:

I wish to submit that the Contract Safai Karamcharies are being issued with medical pass books by the respective Contractors, signed by the respective principal employer.

One Shri G.Raju, a Safai Karamchari, RG-I, secsdor-II, and zone A of Goadavarikhani has approached the Area Hospital, Godavari Khani on 30-09-2020 for the inpatient treatment of his suspecting covid-19 disease.

But the Additional C.M.O has refused to admit to him and harassed the patient mentally stating that there is no provision of inpatient treatment to the out sourced contract workers.

The respective contractor has also escaped from his responsibilities to interfere and help the said worker.

By knowing immediately about said refusal by the COAL BELT AREA BRANCH PRESIDNET of our Union, Shri. G.Srinivas Rao, I have contacted the Chief Medical Officer, Kothagudem and on his interference only, the above said worker was admitted and the treatment is going on, wherein the medical lab reports are shown as negative.

But the mental torched by the superior of the Area Hospital is caused above is not desirable document copies.

1. The procedure laid down to the contract workers for medical Attendants and or treatment to him and his family members
2. Supply of out sourcing manual copy

The Public Information Officer through Letter dated 08-12-2020 furnished and enclosed copy of Letter dated 12-10-2020.

Stating that the appellant was not satisfied with the reply of the Public Information Officer, he filed 1st appeal dated **23-11-2020** before the First Appellate Authority requesting him to furnish the information sought by him u/s 19(1) of the RTI Act, 2005.

Stating that the appellant did not get any response from the First Appellate Authority, he preferred this 2nd appeal before this Commission requesting to arrange to furnish the information sought by him u/s 19(3) of the RTI Act, 2005.

In view of the above, notice is issued to both the parties to attend for hearing on **23-02-2022 at 10.30 AM.**

The Case is heard on 23-02-2022. The appellant is present and stated that the PIO has not furnished the information. The PIO/Sri D,Srinivas, Dy.GM, Corporate, Kothagudem Area, Bhadradi Kothagudem District is present and stated that vide Ref No.CRP/RTI-PIO/3172/1122, dated.08-12-2020 the available information sought was furnished to the appellant through registered post. The PIO further submitted a copy of the information along with the copy of the postal receipt as a proof of dispatch.

Heard both the parties and perused the material papers available on record. The Commission observed that the PIO has not furnished the complete information to the appellant and also the appellant claims that he has not received the information relating to Safayi Karmacharis which he sought through his 6(1) application dated.05-10-2020.

Hence the Commission directs the PIO to furnish the information to the appellant relating to Safayi Karmacharis which the appellant sought through his 6(1) application dated.05-10-2020 within one week through RPAD and to report compliance to the Commission.

With the above direction, the appeal is closed.
