## **Order**

Sri. M. Prabhakar Rao, Hyderabad has filed 2<sup>nd</sup> appeal dated: 14-10-2020 which was received by this Commission on 15-12-2020 for not getting the information sought by him from the PIO / O/o the Tahsildar, Vailpur Mandal, Nizamabad District and 1<sup>st</sup> Appellate Authority / O/o the Revenue Divisional Officer, Nizamabad District.

The brief facts of the case as per the appeal and other records received along with it are that the appellant herein filed an application dated: 11-07-2020 before the PIO requesting to furnish the information under Sec. 6(1) of the RTI Act, 2005, on the following points mentioned in his application:

*Our client states that his father late Sri.Byri Gangaram, S/o. late Sri.Byri Pochanna was one of the allottees of assigned lands under KRCC Commission (Verification Register Proforma 1(a) (Assigned Lands List), along with other Schedule Caste Community members allotted by the then Government in between 1975 to 1986 etc., in favour of the Schedule Caste Community Members of Pachala Nadikuda village of Vailpur Mandal, Nizamabad District, but due to lost of the records pertaining to the said allotted lands, as such our client is not in a position to trace out the said title documents/records.*

Hence, our client is hereby requesting your Hon'ble authority to furnish the following documents/records to the under signed under the R.T.I Act at the earliest.

*Certified copies of the KRCC Commission Verification Register Proforma 1(a)(Assigned Lands List), allotted by the then Government in between 1975 to 1986 etc., in favour of the Schedule Caste Community Members of Pachala Nadikuda village of Vailpur Mandal, Nizamabad District, (Pertaining to late Sri.Byri Gangaram, S/o. late Sri.Byri Pochanna).*

We are herewith paying the requisite fee of Rs.10/- as stipulated under RTI Act, 2005 and also our client is ready to pay the required fees as directed by your authorities.

Stating that the appellant did not receive the information from the PIO, the appellant filed 1<sup>st</sup> appeal dated: 05-10-2020 before the 1<sup>st</sup> Appellate Authority requesting him to furnish the information sought by him u/s 19(1) of the RTI Act.

Stating that the appellant did not get the information from the PIO / 1<sup>st</sup> Appellate Authority even after 30 days of filing his 1<sup>st</sup> appeal, he preferred this 2<sup>nd</sup> appeal before this Commission requesting to take action against the PIO and 1<sup>st</sup> Appellate Authority for not furnishing information sought by him and also to arrange to furnish the information sought by him u/s 19(3) of the RTI Act, 2005.

In view of the above, the 2<sup>nd</sup> appeal may be taken on file and Notices issued to both the parties for hearing on 06-08-2021 at 10.30 A.M.

The case is called on 06-08-2021. A member from the group of advocates who filed the application Sri L. Sai Kumar is present and stated that the PIO has not furnished the information. The PIO / Sri B. Rajashekhar, Deputy Tahsildar, Vailpur Mandal, Nizambad District and Ms. T. Saritha, Senior Assistant representing the O/o the Revenue Divisional Officer, Vailpur Division, Nizambad District are present and filed their affidavit stating that the complete information is brought to the Commission and is ready to be furnished to the appellant.

Heard both the parties and perused the material papers available on record and observed that the appellant filed 6(1) application dated: 11-07-2020 before the PIO seeking certain information. The Commission took a serious view against the PIO for not furnishing the information to the appellant within the stipulated period of 30 days as per Section 7(1) of the RTI Act 2005. The Commission warns the PIO not to repeat such lapses in future and strictly adhere to the provisions of the RTI Act 2005.

The PIO furnished the information to the appellant before the Commission and acknowledged the same.

Since the information is furnished, the appeal is closed.
