## **Order**

Sri Chaturi Bharath Bhushan, Hyderabad has filed 2<sup>nd</sup> appeal dated: 23-08-2020 which was received by this Commission on 28-08-2020 for not getting the information sought by him from the PIO / O/o the Women Development, Child Welfare and Disabled Welfare, Government of Telangana, Telangana Secretariat, Hyderabad and 1<sup>st</sup> Appellate Authority / O/o the Women Development, Child Welfare and Disabled Welfare, Government of Telangana, Telangana Secretariat, Hyderabad.

The brief facts of the case as per the appeal and other records received along with it are that the appellant herein filed an application dated: Nil before the PIO requesting to furnish the information under Sec. 6(1) of the RTI Act, 2005, on the following points mentioned in his application:

- The Subsistence Allowance Payslips (of each month) from March 2019 to November 2019 of Smt. A.Sridevi, ACDPO who earlier worked in ICDS Project, Maldakal of Dept. Of Women Development and Child Welfare, State Govt. of Telangana.
- Was Subsistence Allowance regularly done to Smt. A.Sridevi, ACDPO in par with the other staff in the same office of ICDS Project, Maldakal (YES/NO).
- If YES, Give the details along with the dates and month when the salary was done to the regular staff and when it was done to Smt.A.Sridevi, ACDPO.
- If NO, what were the reasons .... clearly enumerate. I need a detailed explanation why it was not done regularly to her.
- Did Smt. A.Sridevi, ACDPO sent any kind of communication like letters, emails, speed post, phone calls etc., if her Subsistence Allowance was not regularly done.  
If YES, give all the copies from March 2019 to Nov 2019.
- What was the response given by the O/o. The CDPO, ICDS Project, Maldakal in response to these communications.
- In case, if the Subsistence Allowance was not done regularly to Smt. A.Sridevi, the ACDPO, did she tried to take the issue to the notice of any higher authorities like the Principal Secretary, District Collector etc.
- Did the issue of non- disbursement of Subsistence Allowance regularly for Smt.A.Sridevi, ACDPO was taken to the High Court for justice in the last one year (YES/NO).  
If YES, how many times. And, what was the relief given to her by the High Court.

Stating that the appellant did not receive the information from the PIO, the appellant filed 1<sup>st</sup> appeal dated: 12-03-2020 before the 1<sup>st</sup> Appellate Authority requesting him to furnish the information sought by him u/s 19(1) of the RTI Act.

Stating that the appellant did not get the information from the PIO / 1<sup>st</sup> Appellate Authority even after 30 days of filing his 1<sup>st</sup> appeal, he preferred this 2<sup>nd</sup> appeal before this Commission requesting to take action against the PIO and 1<sup>st</sup> Appellate Authority for not furnishing information sought by him and also to arrange to furnish the information sought by him u/s 19(3) of the RTI Act, 2005.

In view of the above, the 2<sup>nd</sup> appeal may be taken on file and Notices issued to both the parties for hearing on 26-08-2021 at 10.30 A.M.

The case is called on 26-08-2021. The appellant is absent. The PIO / Sri B. Saida, Assistant Secretary to Government, O/o the Secretary, WCD & DW, Telangana Secretariat, Hyderabad is present and submitted that vide letter Memo No: 1233/Estt.A1/2020-1 dated: 30-04-2020 the application was transferred to the PIO / O/o the Commissioner, WCD & DW, Hyderabad with a request to furnish the information to the appellant.

The PIO / Smt. T. Aruna, ACDPO, O/o the Commissioner, WCD & DW, Hyderabad is present and submitted that the application was transferred to the PIO / O/o the O/o the District Welfare Officer, WCD&SC, Jogulamba Gadwal District with a request to furnish the information to the appellant.

Heard the PIO and perused the material papers available on record and observed that the appellant filed 6(1) application through online to O/o the Ministry of Women & Child Development, New Delhi and the same was transferred u/s 6(3) to the PIO / O/o the Principal Secretary, WCD & DW, Telangana Secretariat, Hyderabad to furnish the information to the appellant. The Commission is of the view that the earlier appeal No: 6806/SIC-SK/2020 dated: 09-04-2021 was heard by the Commission and the same was disposed off keeping in view that the information was furnished to the appellant vide letter No: 133/RTI/2021 dated: 07-04-2021 by the PIO / O/o the District Welfare Officer, WCD & SC, Jogulamba Gadwal District.

In view of the above, the appeal is closed.
