



Stating that the appellant did not get the information from the PIO / 1<sup>st</sup> Appellate Authority even after 30 days of filing his 1<sup>st</sup> appeal, he preferred this 2<sup>nd</sup> appeal before this Commission requesting to take action against the PIO and 1<sup>st</sup> Appellate Authority for not furnishing information sought by him and also to arrange to furnish the information sought by him u/s 19(3) of the RTI Act, 2005.

In view of the above, the 2<sup>nd</sup> appeal was taken on file and Notices issued to both the parties for hearing on 18-08-2022 at 10.30 A.M.

The case is called on 18-08-2022. The appellant is absent. The PIO / Sri R. Arvind Kumar, District Revenue Officer, O/o the District Collector, Adilabad District is present and filed his affidavit stating that vide letter No: A6/1/0291/2022 dated: 06-01-2022 the application was transferred u/s 6(3) of the RTI Act 2005 to the PIO / O/o the Director, RIMS, Adilabad District with a request to furnish the information to the appellant. The PIO filed copy of the letter along with the postal receipt before the Commission.

Heard the PIO and perused the material papers available on record.

The Commission directs the PIO / O/o the Director, Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Adilabad District to furnish the information to the appellant (keeping in view of Section 8, 9, 10 & 11 of the RTI Act 2005) within Two (2) Weeks from the date of receipt of this order through Registered post with acknowledgement due and to report compliance to the Commission.

With the above direction, the appeal is closed.
